IQAC Summary of Annual Report 2022-2023

It is my great pleasure and privilege in presenting the annual report which contains the institutional development, Faculty achievement and students' achievements in curricular, co curricular and extracurricular activities for this Academic year 2022-2023.

The following are the summary of activities undertaken in our Institution during the Academic year 2022-2023.

At the INSTITUTE LEVEL:

- The NAAC peer team has visited the campus on 28th & 29th July 2022 successfully and with the collaborative contribution of all the faculty, students and stake holders we have been accredited with A⁺ grade by NAAC in the 3rd cycle with CGPA of 3.31 for 4.
- Our library is fully automated with KOHA software and promoted as 24x7 fully functioning.
- Eleven MoUs have been signed with different industries and organizations.
- Technical Symposium has been conducted by Aeronautical department and various related events and competitions were held.


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- Our college has adopted 5 nearby Villages (Melathidiyoor, Singikulam(new) Idayankulam, Soorangudi and Snekalakurichi) under Unnat Bharat Abhiyan (UBA) scheme and 16 extension activities have been conducted.
- DGS inspection for Marine was successfully completed, and we are continuing with A2 grade.
- Totally 31 clubs are actively functioning with minimum 2 activities per year and 1 competition/event by each club within the Institute.
- Three departments namely Mechanical, CSE and EEE have submitted SAR for NBA accreditation in the January, committee visit is expected soon.
- BIIC Business Innovation & Incubation Centre is functioning effectively and likely get grant from government.
- BIIC (Business Innovation & Incubation Centre) conducted workshop on Design Thinking, Critical Thinking and Innovation Design
- With the Entrepreneur Cell, a petty shop is established and the Sales week was conducted by every department to increase the Entrepreneur activity to the students of each department.
- Sales day was organized by BIIC Business Innovation & Incubation Centre and all the students of PSNCET and the students of our sister concern were participated and earned considerable revenue. Program was highly interested and motivational to the students to understand their skills in a different horizon.
- Women Empowerment cell organized many events for female faculty and student
- College campus is maintained with various greenery and is extended to all the academic blocks and road side. Campus continues to maintain as plastic free and drug free.
- Establishment of the PSNCET Co-operative store is on the anvil and the approval process from the district cooperative society is completed and yet to function inside the campus



- Swimming pool is under renovated and students are using it for practice.

FACULTIES:

- Various Professional Development / Administrative Training programmers were organized by the Institution for the up-liftmen of Teaching and Non-teaching faculty members.
- Our faculty has published **132 papers in reputed Journals, and 15** Book chapters.
- 4 Faculty Development programs have been conducted to enhance the knowledge of teaching and technical skills.
- IQAC has organized four quality related seminar/workshop
- IQAC has organized two days Exhibition on 17 Sustainable development Goals developed UN in collaboration with Bharat Soka Gakkai delhi , in which more than 1000 school and our college students visited the Exhibition.
- **Faculties are encouraged to participate in FDPS seminars, workshop conducted outside the campus and 90 of our faculty members have attended in various seminars, webinars, FDP, Workshop and training programs.**
- 3 faculties completed their Ph.D., and 3 of our faculty have registered for research leading to Ph.D degree.

- Sports day had been conducted on 3rd March with Mr.Saravanan, IPS, SP as Chief Guest

STUDENTS:

- All the Student Chapters and department Associations were inaugurated in the month of August.
- In this year, 8 Seminars, 11 Webinars, 2 Symposium and 7 Training Programs have been conducted to enhance the knowledge of students by the various departments.
- 21 Value added courses have been conducted in the latest technology and another 15 are on the anvil, All the UG and PG students availed this opportunity and molded to become employable and industry ready.
- The 21 days Induction Program was conducted for the first year students as per AICTE guidelines. Fresh students were given motivation, training and introducing the basic and advanced level professional skills. Also they were taken to District Science Centre, Tirunelveli as one day visit. Yoga classes were also conducted as life skill.



- One day workshop on How to increase Memory power was conducted for the first year students
- Interested gents Hostel students are getting training and practicing yoga every day morning.
- A special Human value/ personality development seminar is going on for the interested hostel students. This program is conducted in evening 5.30 pm to 7.30 pm on every Wednesdays. This program is offered by ISKON Tirunelveli,
- Training and placement cell has organized three separate training programs to all final year students, third year students and second years in the module of verbal ability, reasoning ability, numerical ability, coding (C,C++, JAVA, PHYTHON), group discussion, interview skills and personality development.
- Our college has arranged placement training exclusively for final years intensive 12 days training by Innate Talent and students got benefitted by it
- Because of this intensive training 156 students received their job offer in various companies such as Faurcea India Pvt Ltd Chennai- 77 students, Alo InfoTech Chennai -06 students, Rampall India Pvt Ltd Chennai -05 students, Techno Automotive India Pvt Ltd Chennai-41 students, Hard n Soft Technologies Tenkasi-06 students, Wipro Infrastructures Pvt Ltd Chennai- 05 students, Sanmina SCI India Pvt Ltd Chennai- 10 students. In addition to this one student in TCS and 4 students in amazon got offer though off campus selection.
- TVSundaram Fastners Madurai, Foxconn chenai and Neel metal Osur have accepted to come over here for drive. Hope that TeliconVeli and Zoho Corporation may also will be added in this list in future.
- Field trips, Industrial visits, In-plant training and Internship to reputed industries were arranged for the students to get hands on experience on recent technological, industrial development and to develop interpersonal relations. 95% of students from all the branches participated and benefitted by this visit / training.



- Marine cadets have participated in Trekking at Singi kulam hills.
- All the UG and PG final year students were encouraged to do their project in the industries and 197 students have got trained through internship.
- Our Management provided fee concession of Rs. -15,15,00 Fifteen lakhs fifteen thousand / on mess fees for the benefit of SC/ST students.
- Our Management provided fee concession of Rs on Rs 32,55,000/- Thirty two lakhs fifty five thousand Tuition and mess fees for the benefit of sports students
- Various Orientation and Motivational programs were conducted for the welfare of Students and students insurance scheme is introduced
- Graduation Day was conducted on 17th September, 2022 total 27 students are awarded with gold medal & rank certificates for their Academic performance.
- In order to inculcate leadership skills and democratic attitude among students PSNCET celebrated National Leaders birth day and Memorial Day such as Teachers day, Gandhi Jayanthi, Science Day, Engineers day and Festivals such as Onam, Pongal, Ayutha pooja, Vinyagar sathurthi and Christmas etc. Many cultural programs, competitions and events are held related to it.
