As the lab is only for third semester once the course is approved by the university purchase order will be sent for procurement of the equipments.
- 10. They suggested going for Deemed to be University status. Chairman replied that after peer team visit by NAAC the work for Deemed to be University status will be stared.
- 11. They suggested creating more public view of the institution. To make public awareness and increase visibility of the institution and its activities more webinar, invited lecture, FDP and all such platform to be integrated.
- 12. To have resource persons for guest lecture from other states especially from north India as well as to invite participants from other states for these activities.
- 13. They asked to improve consultancy.
- 14. They suggested improving placement activities in campus and make students undertake more industrial visit and implant training in companies.
- 15. Suggested to attract start up and expected to establish start up in coming year.
- 16. They suggested preparing newsletter and circulating it to the members so that they will have regular touch with the institution.
- 17. Activities of the college during this one year from July 2021 to May 2022 were appreciated by all the members. Principal assured them that all the suggestion will be implemented in forth coming years
