Resolution 12.16:

RESOLVED THAT, the above value added courses and the respective syllabi framed and approved by the Board of Studies of Electronics and Communication Engineering are ratified.

12.5.2: Approval of AQAR 19-20

The Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR) for the academic year 2019-20 to be submitted to National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) was placed in the Council for the views and comments of the members. After a detailed discussion on the AQAR the following resolution was passed.

Resolution 12.17:

RESOLVED THAT, the AQAR for the academic year 2019-20 to be submitted to NAAC is approved. The IQAC Coordinator is authorized to submit the AQAR to NAAC before the deadline in consultation with the Principal.

12.5.3: Approvals related to academic matters of the college

A. As per the eligibility criteria prescribed by Director General of Shipping (DGS), Mumbai, a student can join second year of B.E. Marine Engineering course if he/she has the following minimum academic qualification.

"Candidates can join 2nd year of 4-year Marine Engineering Degree Course who have passed 1st year from the Engineering College in other Streams like Mechanical or Electrical approved by AICTE with minimum 60% average marks"

This was placed in the Academic Council for approval.

After detailed deliberations and discussions the following resolution was passed.

Resolution 12.18:

RESOLVED THAT, as per the eligibility criteria prescribed by the Director General of Shipping (DGS), Mumbai, the students who have scored a minimum of 60% marks in the 1st year Electrical or Mechanical stream of PSN College of Engineering and Technology shall be admitted in the 2nd year of B.E. Marine Engineering offered by PSN College of Engineering and Technology.

B. The Chairman of the Academic Council informed the members about the decision taken to surrender B.E. Electronics and Instrumentation Engineering programme and instead B.E.

Biomedical and Robotic Engineering programme shall be introduced with 30 seats. The programme will be started after appropriate approvals are obtained from the competent authorities.

All the members of the Academic Council welcomed the decision and asked the Chairman, Academic Council to go ahead on the decision taken.

C. As per Regulations 2014, every student admitted under autonomous regulation has to earn 20 extra credits to complete the degree. The extra credits are awarded on various items including participation in social awareness programmes, publication of research papers, completion of value added courses, NPTEL courses and many more. As per Regulations 2014, there is a ceiling in earning extra credits under each item.

In the prevailing pandemic situation it is difficult for the students to span all items and earn extra credits as prescribed in Regulation 2014. Considering this extraordinary situation, requests have been received from the Heads of departments to remove the ceiling in earning extra credits for the current final year students who are going to complete their programme in April-May 2021. This was placed before the Academic Council for approval.

Resolution 12.19:

RESOLVED THAT, considering the prevailing pandemic situation, the ceiling prescribed in the activities and courses for earning extra credits under Regulation 2014 shall not be followed for the students appearing for their final year examination in April – May 2021. The prescribed 20 credits shall be calculated by putting together the credits earned through all the activities and courses done by the student during his period of study without applying any ceiling as prescribed in Regulation 2014. This is applicable only for the students who are appearing for their final year examination during April-May 2021.
