The programme was planned as per the syllabi of Anna University for the first year students of 2023-2027. The programme consisting of Goal setting, General Ethics, Self-discipline, Self-motivation, Creative Arts, Aptitude, Anti-ragging awareness etc., has been delivered by the various experts.

Dr. V. Manikandan, Principal, PSNCET has delivered the topic on the general ethics. He explained the general ethics in a broader sense, ethics reflects on human beings and their interaction with nature and with other humans, on freedom, on responsibility and on justice. From his lecture students got benefitted by knowing the principles of general ethics and able to apply his/her life.
